**Synopsis:**

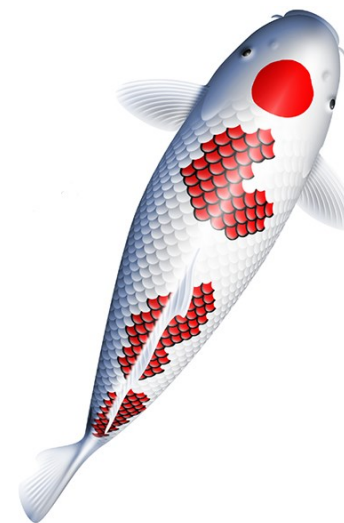
